43° 7:20 dry. Gas at Shell near Mary's.

41° Siskiyou Summit bare & dry. High blanket of light
grey clouds. Randolph-Collier rest area for ablations
& breakfast. Grateful for no fog. Little Shasta (^{Black}
^{Butte}) backlit with orange sunset band. Snow striations.
Big Shasta shrouded. Sculptured oak. Dinosaur
sculpture NB.

Arrive Kathleen Epps in Winters at 1 pm. Richard & Mo live on the property. Kathleen is oldest of 6 siblings. Brother James died of cancer from Agent Orange in Vietnam. Chris, a retired hospice nurse, is a tiny little thing with lung damage from smoking. Lives in Livermore. Husband Mark is very funny. Retired middle school teacher & V.P. who still subs. Mary lives in Livermore, manages properties, & loved working at a hardware store. She seemed a bit neuro-divergent. Made yummy pumpkin bread. Sue, age 73, is a retired nurse practitioner who worked in women's health. Lived in Portland for 32 years. Now in Alameda to be near her two daughters.

Leftovers for dinner. Yum! Brussels sprouts, au gratin potatoes, etc. I also ate lots of cheesecake! Chilly outside. Brief firepit time.

Home at 9.

Thurs Dec. 26

Up early to sleeping condo. Coffee, exercises. Walk to Fry's for yeast (for pizza), yogurt, pineapple (for pizza). Grant making pizza dough. Mom at wicked movie. David prepping for pizza party at "Marcellos" (Mark's).

Mon Dec 30

Dinner at Walmart Subway in Sacramento. Drove another hour to Maxwell rest area, arriving a little after 7. 50°.

Colin working at Hotel Del "Ocean Club at the Del" restaurant, teaching fitness classes (he got his personal trainer cert), & occasional acro gigs (\$1200 to perform at casino on NYE). His sublet is up in Feb. & he hopes to move to Saratoga Apts, in DB proper, where many acro friends live.

Tues Dec 31

42°~~40°~~ at 6:30 am. Quiet night. Trucks separated from cars, so no idling thrubs. Beautiful orange sunrise. 7:30 drive to Sacramento nwr, 15 miles away. Magical place. Thousands of birds, clouds of geese wheeling in the air. 6-mile auto loop. White-fronted geese I think was new species for me. Loggerhead shrike, cinnamon teal, many ducks

Stopped at viewing platform. Loud gabbling of geese. Chilly day but nice in sun. Great morning light for seeing birds.

Snowgeese visible much closer than Skagit Valley. On ponds instead of in fields.

Two-mile walk for me. Saw a bittern!

Counted about 25 species. Visitor center closed.

Tear ourselves away at 10:15. Shasta & Lassen both visible, snowcovered. Light traffic. High thin clouds. Rolling hills gas, exit 628, #3.39. Lunch at "Smiles" rest area (Herbert S. Miles). Bread, cheese, hummus, veggies, olives. Yum.

Love the oak forests & high plains. Shasta: white cone against white sky.

Stop at Grocery Outlet in Weed so Grant can look for Smokey Jim's BBQ sauce. No luck. Turns out that ~~main~~ Weed ~~is~~ town is one exit north.

Siskyou Summit bare & dry, no snow near road, 31°. At 4 pm, near Roseburg, started to rain. Lots of DUI patrol for New Years. Stop at Gittings rest area south of Eugene at 5:30. Dinner same as lunch. Got dark at 5 and visibility in the dark & rain was poor so we

will stay here for the night. 41° & raining.

Grant wanted to come home thru Bend to buy some used track burner track. But it's very cold there, with snow predicted, and would have been a very cold night. Woke at midnight to a few distant fireworks/explosions.

Wed Jan. 1, 2025

Woke at 6:30 to heavy rain. 40°. Start driving at 7:30. Barely light. Traffic blissfully light - holiday. Rain stops 8:30. Home 11:10 pm.
